„Diagnosing Chinese Economy“

The aftermath of the investment bubble is taking much clearer shape in China. There are two good news and two bad news.

Good news are: aside from heavy industries facing severe glut, there are also fast growing “new economies” in IT or service industries; and the government has sufficient power to manage and sustain economic growth for the time being.

Bad news are: as the personnel reshuffle in the state leadership coming close, Xi Jinping needs to make further compromise with vested interests, which makes it more difficult to proceed with SOE reforms or “Zombie” company disposal; and that new bubbles are still generating in real estate and financial market due to a strong market belief that the government would not let financial risks become a reality.

Speaker

Toshiya Tsugami is President of Tsugami Workshop Ltd., an independent China business consulting firm from Japan.

Mr. Tsugami was born in 1957. He graduated from University of Tokyo (Faculty of Law) in 1980, and served for Japan’s Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) and experienced China’s WTO entrance negotiations. He served as Economic Counselor at the Japanese Embassy in Beijing and METI’s Director for Northeast Asia.

He is now working as an independent China business consultant and is one of the most famous and dispassionate Chinese Economy watchers in Japan.

His book „China’s rise“ won the „Suntory Prize for Social Sciences and Humanities“ in 2003. His recent book „The End of China’s rise“ had a wide public echo in Japan.
